Rules/regulations:

- Appropriate dress is required. Please adhere to the PHHS student dress code. Shoes are also required.
 - You **MUST** bring your Student ID and ticket to the dance to be granted access.
 - Students may start arriving at 8:15 p.m. Please note, though, that prom ends promptly at 11:30 pm; if someone is picking you up after the dance, your ride needs to be here promptly at 11:30 pm. Please make all after-the-dance arrangements prior to coming to the dance.
 - Appropriate behavior will be expected once inside the dance. Any student demonstrating aggressive or inappropriate behavior at the dance will be asked to leave with no refund of monies.
 - Students must be passing all classes with a grade of a C or better, and not be on any sort of behavior or academic probation to attend the dance, unless approved prior by administration. A grade-check will be done Monday, April 20th. All students with grades less than a C will be notified of their inability to attend the dance. Any student that purchases a ticket and is ineligible to attend will be given a full refund for their prom ticket.
- Guests from other schools must return a signed Guest permission slip from their Parent/Guardian, as well as receive permission from administration 48 hours in advance of the event.

Formal Dance Dress Code:

- No see through fabric
- No midriff blouses or tops
- Cannot reveal undergarments or skin
- No skin tight or excessively baggy clothing.
- No clothing with inappropriate language or gestures
- All dresses & skirts must be no shorter than 4" above the knee.
- All dresses and tops must be within 4" of the base of the neck (no exposed cleavage)
- Wear clothing as if you are attending a "dressy" occasion; no jeans, t-shirts, hats, etc.
- Dresses that are strapless, sleeveless, tank tops, halter tops, or cover only one shoulder will be allowed, but must NOT show any cleavage, and **MUST** be within 4" of the base of the neck.

PHHS Staff and Chaperones reserve the right to determine appropriate attire and to refuse entry to any student that does not meet proper Dance Dress Code.
