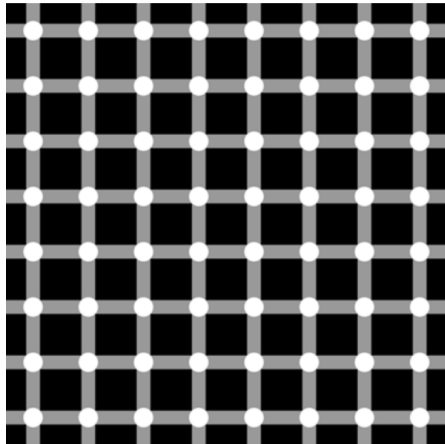

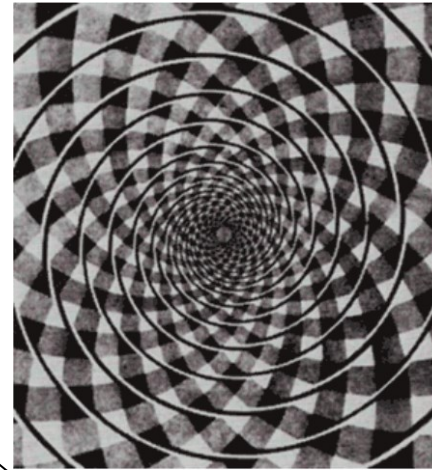

Look at the picture to the right. Are all the dots white, gray, or black? Explain your answer.



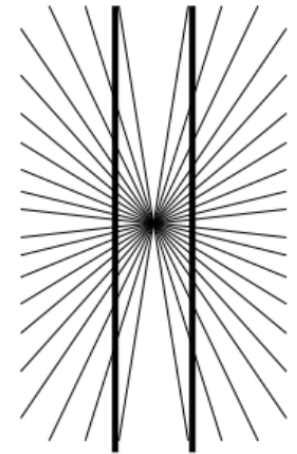
WEDNESDAY brain teaser
